Our School Improvement Plan this year builds on the strong practices we have established over the past several years. We will continue to refine and develop reading lessons and instructional practices in all grades. Our goal is for each lesson to have a clear purpose with teacher modeling and questioning to support student access to grade level content. Teacher teams will continue to come together weekly to collaborate and plan for literacy and math instruction using culturally responsive strategies and practices. Our entire staff is committed to working in partnership with our families and our school community, striving to be a school where ALL feel welcomed and valued. In addition to our amazing students, the incredibly dedicated staff and families at Franklin are what contribute largely to making our school a thriving school. As a school that serves students aged 4-8, we are able to be keenly focused on the foundational skills students need to be successful throughout their lives.

Progress

We have made great progress in the continuation of meaningfully using data to inform instructional decisions, flexibly grouping students across classrooms during literacy instruction, and working in teams to align curriculum across our classrooms and grade levels. Our climate survey data has markedly improved for both staff and families over the past two years with Family Engagement and Parent Relationships rising to 94% of families feeling welcomed and included at our school. We met our PALs proficiency goal this past spring. Eighty six percent of our first and second graders are at proficiency.

Area for Growth

As a school, we embrace continuous improvement. This year we will focus on professional learning around using questions and scaffolds in whole group literacy and math instruction.

Vision Connection

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. Through these skills and abilities, our students will graduate college, career, and community ready.

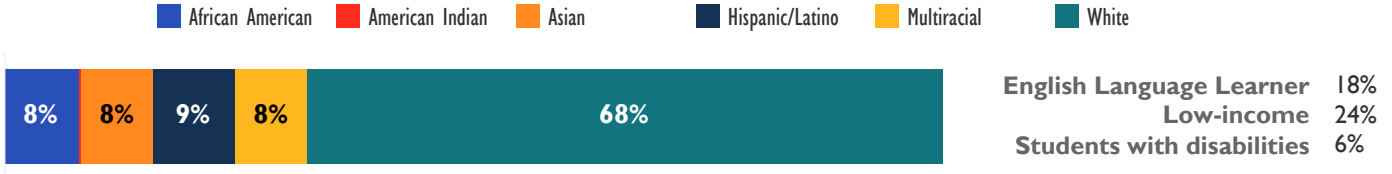

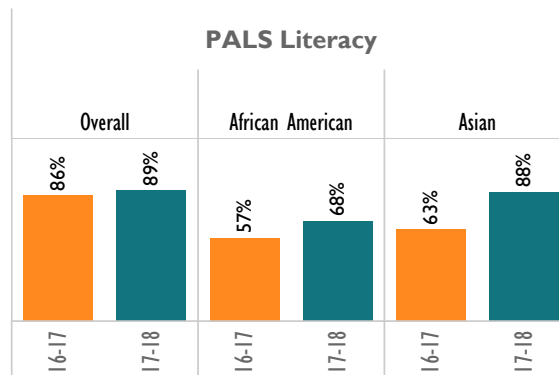

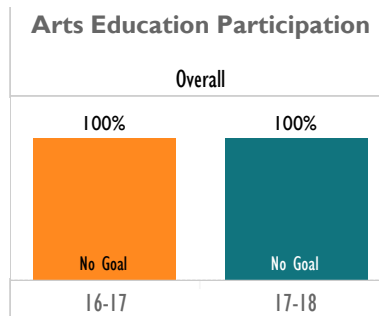


Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
